Holy Baptism, Rite II

The Celebrant bids the baptismal party to approach the center opening at the communion rail. The congregation remains seated.

PRESENTATION AND EXAMINATION OF THE CANDIDATE

Celebrant

The Candidate for Holy Baptism will now be presented.

Parents and Godparents I present Leslie Charles Jackson III to receive the Sacrament of Baptism. Celebrant asks the parents and godparents

Will you be responsible for seeing that the child you present is brought up in the Christian faith and life?

Parents and Godparents I will, with God's help.

Celebrant

Will you by your prayers and witness help this child to grow into the full stature of Christ?

Parents and Godparents I will, with God's help.

Then the Celebrant asks of the parents and godparents who speak on behalf of the infant

Question Answer	Do you renounce Satan and all the spiritual forces of wickedness that rebel against God? I renounce them .
Question Answer	Do you renounce the evil powers of this world which corrupt and destroy the creatures of God? I renounce them .
Question	Do you renounce all sinful desires that draw you from the love of God?
Answer	I renounce them.
Question	Do you turn to Jesus Christ and accept him as your Savior?
Answer	I do .
Question	Do you put your whole trust in his grace and love?
Answer	I do .
Question Answer	Do you promise to follow and obey him as your Lord? I do .

Celebrant addresses the congregation, saying

Will you who witness these vows do all in your power to support this person in his life in Christ?

People We will.

Celebrant

Let us join with Charlie who is committing himself to Christ and renew our own baptismal covenant.

A procession forms and leads the families and sponsors of the Candidates to the baptism font.

Prayers for the Candidate

The Celebrant then says to the congregation

Let us now pray for this person who is to receive the Sacrament of new birth.

Leader	Deliver <i>him</i> O Lord, from the way of sin and death.
People	Lord, hear our prayer.
Leader	Open <i>his heart</i> to your grace and truth.
People	Lord, hear our prayer.
Leader	Fill <i>him</i> with your holy and life-giving Spirit.
People	Lord, hear our prayer.
Leader	Keep <i>him</i> in the faith and communion of your holy Church.
People	Lord, hear our prayer.
Leader	Teach <i>him</i> to love others in the power of the Spirit.
People	Lord, hear our prayer.
Leader	Send <i>him</i> into the world in witness to your love.
People	Lord, hear our prayer.
Leader	Bring <i>him</i> to the fullness of your peace and glory.
People	Lord, hear our prayer.

Celebrant says

Grant, O Lord, that all who are baptized into the death of Jesus Christ your Son may live in the power of his resurrection and look for him to come again in glory; who lives and reigns now and for ever. **Amen**.

THANKSGIVING OVER THE WATER

Celebrant blesses the water, first saying

	The Lord be with you.
People	And also with you.
Celebrant	Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.
People	It is right to give him thanks and praise.

We thank you, Almighty God, for the gift of water. Over it, the Holy Spirit moved in the beginning of creation. Through it, you led the children of Israel out of their bondage in Egypt into the land of promise. In it your Son Jesus received the baptism of John and was anointed by the Holy Spirit as the Messiah, the Christ, to lead us, through his death and resurrection, from the bondage of sin into everlasting life.

We thank you, Father, for the water of Baptism. In it, we are buried with Christ in his death. By it, we share in his resurrection. Through it, we are reborn by the Holy Spirit. Therefore in joyful obedience to your Son, we bring into his fellowship those who come to him in faith, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

At the following words, the Celebrant touches the water

Now sanctify † this water, we pray you, by the power of your Holy Spirit, that those who here are cleansed from sin and born again may continue for ever in the risen life of Jesus Christ our Savior.

To him, to you, and to the Holy Spirit, be all honor and glory, now and for ever. Amen.

THE BAPTISM

The candidate is presented by name to the Celebrant, or to an assisting priest or deacon, who then immerses, or pours water upon, the candidates, saying

Charlie, I baptize you in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Then the Priest places a hand on the person's head, marking on the forehead the sign of the cross [using Chrism if desired] and says

Charlie, you are sealed by the Holy Spirit in Baptism and marked as Christ's own for ever. **Amen**.

When this action has been completed for the candidate, the Priest, at a place in full sight of the congregation, prays over him, saying

Heavenly Father, we thank you that by water and the Holy Spirit you have bestowed upon this your servant the forgiveness of sin, and have raised *him* to the new life of grace. Sustain *him*, O Lord, in your Holy Spirit. Give *him* an inquiring and discerning heart, the courage to will and to persevere, a spirit to know and to love you, and the gift of joy and wonder in all your works. **Amen**.

A procession forms and leads the parents and the newly baptized to the center of the communion rail. Other members of the baptismal party return to their pews. The Altar Party returns to the sanctuary.

Let us welcome the newly baptized.

Celebrant and People
